BRUSSELS PRIDE - THE BELGIAN AND EUROPEAN PRIDE 2023

My participation in Brussels Pride - The Belgian & European Pride 2023 implies that I support (me - my organisation - my party) * the following points:

With respect to the LGBTQIA+ community, the signatory undertakes to:

- Actively fight for equal rights and equal treatment for LGBTQIA+ people in Belgium and around the world.
- actively combat all forms of discrimination on the basis of sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, sexual characteristics or gender expression.
- actively combat homo-, lesbo-, bi-, trans-, intersex- and serophobia.
- Contribute to the communication and support of Brussels Pride - The Belgian and European Pride 2023's theme: **"Protect the Protest"**.

- Sign up to and respect the charters of previous Belgian Prides.

In general terms, the signatory refers to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights** and clearly rejects any form of discrimination on the grounds described in Belgian discrimination law, namely:

- nationality, presumed race, skin colour, origin, ethnic origin, nationality, age, gender, disability, religion or belief, marital status, birth, means, political affiliation, current or future health status, physical or genetic properties, social origin, gender identity, gender expression, sex, language or trade union beliefs.
